

MWA Connected Learning Involvement Options

We are pleased to be able to offer several different options for high school connected learning experiences, and are committed to working with you and your student to determine the best option for your family!

Connected Learning Tiers of Involvement:

- ***Connected Campus:*** refers to a Connected Learning site with a minimum of six full-time students enrolled in grades 9/10 or 11/12 or ten students in grades 9-12. MWA finances a facilitator to supervise the campus.
- ***Connected Individual Plan:*** refers to a Connected Learning site/home with 1-5 full-time students enrolled. The local site is responsible for financing/arranging a facilitator to supervise students.
- ***Connected a la Carte:*** This per-class option is designed to allow non-MWA students the ability to take electives or specialized classes through Maplewood Academy. Under this option, each family is responsible for individual supervision of the enrolled student.

Financial Planning

Individual Technology Costs: Students connecting from home or on an a la carte basis are provided with a laptop and the necessary software to connect in to live MWA classes. These costs are rolled into the registration and tuition payments. The individual family/site is responsible for financing and maintaining adequate internet access.

Campus/Site Technology Costs: There are several technology configurations available for sites/campuses, and the equipment and setup costs range from \$2,000-8,000 per classroom, depending on the needs and goals of the location.
