The facilitator also assists each course teacher with administrative tasks, provides support to students academically as needed, builds positive relationships with students, and acts as a Maplewood Academy campus representative for with students, families, and community stakeholders. The facilitator works with the VP for Connected Learning and course teachers to create and maintain a positive and effective learning environment for students and build a sense of community on the connected campus.
