SCHOOL ORGANIZATION	Maplewood operates a work/study program, providing the students with both academic and vocational training. Classes are taught on a modified block schedule, meeting a minimum of 200 minutes per week (Lab classes = 240 minutes). Grades are given on a two-semester system.

CLASS RANK	Students are ranked numerically according to grade point averages. All courses with a letter grade are included. Total class enrollment is included in computing class rank. Class rank shows on students' transcripts.

GRADUATION	<p>Maplewood offers two diploma options: General or Advanced College Prep.</p> <p>22 units of credit are required for the general diploma. (.5 credits for each semester course completed with a passing grade). TECHNOLOGY	<p>Each Maplewood Academy student is provided a personal laptop to use for the school year. Classes are both video-conferenced and recorded for students who connect with us online.</p>
STUDENT ETHNICITY	<p>MWA has a diverse group of students from many ethnic backgrounds. (36% Hispanic, 32% Caucasian, 20% African American, 9% Asian)</p>
INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS	<p>MWA accepts students with valid F-1 visas who meet our entrance requirements. Currently enrolled students are from China, Korea, Ethiopia, and Mexico. MWA does not teach ESL classes at this time. Satisfactory score on the TOEFL is required.</p>
POST HIGH SCHOOL	<p>93% of last year's graduating class went on to 4 year colleges or universities. 5-7% attended community colleges. 74% attended Adventist colleges or universities.</p>
